

Mouse Locator :: Version 1.1 :: Version History

New Features:

- Version 1.1 is a universal binary, it can be used on Macintosh computers powered by either PowerPC or Intel processors. Mac OS X version 10.4 is required.
- Added 'infinite' setting to the trigger time control, allowing the Locator to be displayed using the hot key alone.
- Added 'infinite' setting to the display time control, preventing the Locator from being dismissed automatically. When selected, the Locator must be dismissed using the hot key, or if enabled, with a mouse button click.
- More locations have been included in the search for custom graphic files. Mouse Locator will search in the following folders in the listed order. When a suitable graphic file is found, the search will terminate.
 1. ~/Library/Mouse Locator/ (i),(ii)
 2. ~/Pictures/ (i)
 3. /Library/Mouse Locator/ (ii)

(i) ~ is the path to the current home folder, (ii) 'Mouse Locator' contains 1 space character
- Improved interoperability with Exposé and Dashboard. As a result the Exposé immunity option, where Mouse Locator could be hidden when Exposé is active is no longer required.
- French localization of the Preferences Pane provided by Laure Guggenheim.

Bug Fixes:

- Addressed an issue that would cause the Locator to display as a white square when the frontmost application had taken control of the entire screen.
